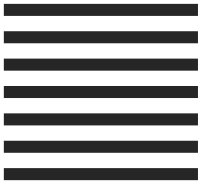

"I was very surprised with the results," recalled Wynker. "I was able to cut six cows from the herd and still increase my milk production. It was incredible!"

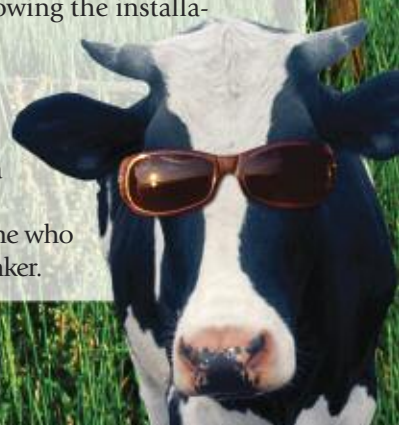
Wynker also noticed benefits for the barn in the winter.
